In the Eastern Cape, military bases include: Naval Station Port Elizabeth - provides support to visiting ships, no major vessels are based here. Naval Base Durban - This base was scaled down to a naval station in 2002 with the rationalisation of the fleet.

The Navy operates the following naval bases: Naval Base Simon's Town- The base houses the frigate and submarine flotillas as well as support vessels.
