What are the different classifications of occupancy and use?

Different classifications of occupancy and use represent varying levels of hazard and risk to building occupants and adjacent properties. 302.1 Occupancy classification. Occupancy classification is the formal designation of the primary purpose of the building, structure or portion thereof.

Does a special amusement building have a occupant load of 75?

Special amusement buildings having an occupant load of 75 or more shall comply with the requirements for the appropriate Group A occupancy and Sections 411.1 through 411.8. Special amusement buildings having an occupant load of less than 75 shall comply with the requirements for a Group B occupancy and Sections 411.1 through 411.8.

Do fire barriers separating Group H and I-2 occupancies reduce fire-resistance ratings?

However, fire barriers separating Group H and I-2 occupancies shall not be permitted any reductions in fire-resistance ratings. Each fire area shall comply with this code based on the occupancy of that space. Each fire area shall comply with the height limitations based on the occupancy of that space and the type of construction classification.

What are institutional occupancies?

Institutional occupancies shall be classified as Group I-1, I-2, I-3 or I-4. This occupancy shall include buildings, structures or parts thereof housing more than 16 persons, on a 24-hour basis, who because of age, mental disability or other reasons, live in a supervised residential environment that provides personal care services.
