Could China's solar panels help meet Africa's energy needs?

Where are solar panels coming from in Africa?

In North Africa, countries like Algeria and Egypt are building massive utility-scale solar power plants that require large numbers of panels. But in Sub-Saharan Africa, the panels are being imported by more rural communities in places that traditionally haven't been connected to the grid at all.

What is China doing with solar panels?

It's part of China's global ascendancy in the manufacture and sale of renewable energy technologies. Its companies make the vast majority of solar panels, along with the cells and wafers that go into them.
