What are electricity shut off laws in Georgia?

Electricity shut off laws in Georgia are essential for balancing utility companies' operations with consumer rights. These regulations ensure fair and transparent disconnection procedures, addressing concerns about unexpected disruptions.

What happens if a utility shuts off in winter?

In winter, an electric or gas utility must confirm that forecasted temperatures will not drop below 10°F during the 48 hours starting between 7:00 - 10:00 a.m. on the planned shut-off date; if the forecast falls under that threshold, the disconnection may not proceed.

What happens if a utility bill is disputed in Georgia?

If all remedial measures with the utility have failed, request that the Georgia Public Service Commission investigate the dispute. This request must be made within 10 days of receiving the disputed bill. Any late charges assessed in the case of a disputed bill shall be refunded if it is determined that the customer does not owe the bill.

What can I do if my utility shuts off in Michigan?
