What is the electricity price in Iceland?

The residential electricity price in Iceland is ISK 25.756 per kWh or USD 0.203. The electricity price for businesses is ISK 12.470 kWh or USD 0.098. These retail prices were collected in March 2025 and include the cost of power, distribution and transmission, and all taxes and fees. Compare Iceland with 150 other countries.

How much electricity does Iceland use?

In 2015, the total electricity consumption in Iceland was 18,798 GWh. Renewable energy provided almost 100% of electricity production, with about 73% coming from hydropower and 27% from geothermal power. Most of the hydropower plants are owned by Landsvirkjun (the National Power Company) which is the main supplier of electricity in Iceland.

The average price of electricity in Iceland, in June of 2024, has been 0.1702EUR per kilowatt hour. Electricity price has increased EUR 0.0088 kWh, 5.45% since the previous semester.
