The terminal is equipped with facilities required for operating a container terminal such as operation building, gate house, workshop building, substation, etc..

The port can handle 20 ft, 40 ft and 45 ft containers, and these facilities are provided by 3 companies that oversee 4 terminals. The facilities are in good condition.
