**How much power does the UK import from Europe?**

The UK is importing record amounts of power from Europe, with the country spending more than £250 million on power from abroad each month, new analysis by Drax Electric Insights has found. A record 20% of the country's electricity demand was met by imports from Europe during the second quarter of 2024.

**How much power does Great Britain import a year?**

Net imports have accounted for 15% of GB power, enough for 10.8 million homes. This puts Great Britain on track to import nearly 36 TWh over the whole year, 46% higher than the previous record of 24.6 TWh set in 2021.

**Which country imports the most electricity to the UK?**

National Grid operates six interconnectors with nuclear from France, the leading source of imported electricity to the UK. Net electricity imports from France to the UK totalled 12.7 TWh last year according to government data, with nuclear making up the bulk of that power. France's grid is made up of around 70% nuclear.
