How many people live in Juba IDP camp 3?

Of the occupants, 49% are female and 51% are male - 80% of the occupants are adults and 20% are children.

Juba IDP Camp 3: There are 24,115 people [7,151 households] living in this site. There are both internally displaced and people who left the country prior, and then returned to South Sudan and now live in the camp.

What is Juba IDP camp 3?

Juba IDP Camp 3 Site was established in 2013 and has 25,119 individuals currently seeking protection from armed conflict in the site. Ten blocks currently exist in the camp with 7,098 households. Monitor service provision in the sites and flag any duplication or gaps in service provision.

How many displaced people live in Juba?

As of January 2022, approximately 33,000 displaced persons reside in Juba IDP sites compared to the 31,000 people reported in January 2021. While the numbers of people have not grown exponentially, some people who originally displaced then moved out of the Juba sites, and others then displaced and took their place.
